Details for the Costume Class

How To Enter

There is no entry fee, nor will there be payback in this class. Prizes will be awarded in the Costume class (453) in 3 categories — “First Impression,” “Most Time Committed,” and “Originality.” Each participant is allowed no more than one animal entries for this contest.

Rules and Regulations

- 1) Both the participant and the horse need to have a costume. Paint is accepted.
- 2) Animal must be calm and controlled or they will not be admitted to the arena. Participants will be walking their horse with a lead rope, no riding will be allowed.
- 3) Costume may cover the animal's head, but must allow them to see. Same for participant.
- 4) Participants must not be secured to animal in any way, to prevent accidents from occurring.
- 5) Participants under the age of 6 must have an adult walk with them in the arena.
- 6) Costume may touch the ground, but should not drag behind the horse or extend out more than 6 inches from their nose.
- 7) Horses must have a halter on at all times. No exceptions.
- 8) Participants must have close-toed shoes on at all times.
- 9) NO entry will be admitted if the costume is inappropriate in any way.
- 10) If your animal acts up or becomes a danger to other participants while in the arena, you will be asked to leave and will therefore be disqualified from the class.

How Winners are Determined

There will be one judge and the judge will not be from the CKD area as to prevent bias in selecting winners. There will be 3 winners in the class, one from each category mentioned above. The judge reserves the right to reject any entry deemed unacceptable due to content or noncompliance with contest rules.

Contest Eligibility

We ask that those participating are at least 5 years old and are able to control the animal with ease so no injuries occur. Entries can include horses, ponies, mules, miniature horses or donkeys. You do not have to own the animal, but the owner must sign the waiver form attached.
