TRI-RIVERS FAIR
Rules for Commercial Vendors (inside)

1. Vendor spaces are 10' wide x 8' deep. A table and two chairs will be provided.
2. Set-up will be Wednesday, 3:00-6:00 p.m. All booths **must** be completed by 6:00 p.m.
3. The building will be open to the public and booths **must** be in operation the following hours:
Thursday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Friday & Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
4. Tear-down will be Sunday, 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
5. Exhibitors are not permitted to install machinery that might be objectionable in sound or endanger the safety of patrons. The use of public address, amplifiers, or other attention devices or systems by exhibitors will not be permitted.
6. Exhibitors will keep their exhibits, equipment, and demonstrations within their defined booth areas. No demonstrations or soliciting in the aisle.
7. No food or opened drink will be sold or given away with the exception of your product. No beer or other alcoholic beverages will be sold or dispensed in any way. No matches or peanuts/seeds/etc. in the shell shall be given out by exhibitors.
8. All electrical needs will be charged (\$10) to the exhibitor and must be marked on the contract. Exhibitors must provide their own extension cords, etc.
9. Fee (without added electrical fee, see #8): \$75.00
NO REFUNDS AFTER JUNE 15th, for any reason.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for their own security, during operating hours. The building will be locked outside of set-up, operating, and tear-down hours.
11. The Saline County Fair Association TRI-RIVERS FAIR is not liable for loss or damage to any exhibit.

EXHIBIT SELECTION IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE FAIR BOARD AND WE HAVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE.

Rules for Commercial Vendors (outside)

1. Vendor spaces are 16' wide x 8' deep.
2. Set-up is Wednesday. All spaces **must** be completed and exhibits in place by 7:00 p.m.
3. Spaces **must** be in operation all day Thursday-Saturday and Sunday until 5:00 p.m.
4. Tear-down will be Sunday, 5:00-9:00 p.m.
5. Exhibitors are not permitted to install machinery that might be objectionable in sound or endanger the safety of patrons. The use of public address, amplifiers, or other attention devices or systems by exhibitors will not be permitted without the permission of the Fair Board. Any system permitted must be operated at a moderate volume so as not to create annoyances to other exhibitors.
6. Exhibitors will keep their exhibits, equipment, and demonstrations within their defined spaces. No roaming of the grounds.
7. No food or opened drink will be sold or given away with the exception of your product. No beer or other alcoholic beverages will be sold or dispensed in any way. No matches or peanuts/seeds/etc. in the shell shall be given out by exhibitors.
8. All electrical needs will be charged (\$25) to the exhibitor and must be marked on the contract. Exhibitors must provide their own extension cords, etc.
9. Fees (without added electrical fee, see #8):
1 space-\$75.00, 2 spaces-\$125.00, 3 spaces-\$162.50, 4 spaces-\$200.00
NO REFUNDS AFTER JUNE 15th, for any reason.
10. Exhibitors are responsible for their own security.
11. The Saline County Fair Association TRI-RIVERS FAIR is not liable for loss or damage to any exhibit.

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
